Clipping



Push

Remove backing from the blade packaging, hold clipper body at a 45-degree angle and snap on single-use blade 9660.

NOTE: An audiable snap indicates the blade is securely attached.

Remove

To remove the blade, use your thumb to "pop off" the used blade into a sharps waste receptacle.

NOTE: Always use a new blade for each patient to avoid cross-contamination.



Cleaning

Rinse

With the clipper uncorded and in the "off" position and the blade removed, rinse the handle under warm running water. Dry thoroughly before recharging or reusing.

NOTE: Do not submerse clipper body in any liquid solution



Pull

Position the blade flat or at a slight angle on the skin surface and gently pull the clipper toward you.

NOTE: Do not rake the blade across the patient's skin





Wipe

With the clipper in the "off" position and the blade removed, wipe the clipper handle with an alcohol or disinfectant wipe.



Charge

Before initial use, charge clipper for 18-24 hours. After each use, store the clipper handle in the "off" position in the plugged-in charge stand. Clipper provides approximately 100 minutes of cordless run time on a 12-14 hour recharge.

NOTE: There is no risk of overcharging, but after the initial use, charging for more than 14 hours will not result in longer run time
